Photodocumentation

- Utilizes photos or videos to document physical exam findings.
- Adjunct to physical examination.
- Educational potential.

- Photo-documentation only via Epic Haiku
- Photos must be documented in note on day of service
- Images are not stored on capturing device

- I agree to let X Health Services use digital recording or photography for clinical/ educational purposes.


I understand:


- Adequate lighting
 - Glare/ Shadow
- In focus
- Distance from camera to lesion/ruler
- Distance from ruler is to lesion
- Clear which part of body



PRACTICE – potential barriers


- It won't work on my phone.

Smooth, black mouse




